## **Staff Planning and School Self Evaluation**

At our half in half out staff planning meeting on February 5<sup>th</sup>, the curriculum subject that we are panning for at present and reviewing is Maths. The Department of Education have introduced a new Maths curriculum and we have to compile a whole school plan on the teaching of Maths in line with the new curriculum.

School Self Evaluation is where we have to review one specific area of our teaching and learning in Toonagh NS. This year we are focussing on Irish with a particular emphasis on improving the pupils' oral Irish. After the midterm break classes from  $1^{st} - 6^{th}$  will have an online interactive Irish reading book to read and engage with each week from the Leigh Anois website. This is an excellent online resource of levelled Irish books for each class  $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ . Each week the children will write the name of the book in their homework journal that they are reading and they will access this book from the website above. The children are asked to read and engage with the book that their teacher has prescribed for them each week. We also have other strategies in place to promote the pupil's oral Irish in Toonagh N.S. over the next two school terms.

Toonagh NS has a responsibility to cover the Relationships and Sexuality Education (R.S.E.) section of the Social, Personal and Health Education (S.P.H.E.) strand of the Curriculum.
