Dear Parent(s),

Everyone has settled back well in Toonagh NS and well done to all the children.

There are a number of important items that I would like to bring to your attention in this back to school newsletter:

School Fees Payment 2022-23:

We are dependant on a school fees charge to help the school alleviate the cost of some resources which are so beneficial to the children in Toonagh NS. Please see more detailed letter attached to this newsletter with the breakdown of our School Fees Collection 2022-23.

An epayment request for the school fees 2022-23 will issue in the coming days. This payment will include a fee for pupil insurance (24 hour, 365 day cover), and a contribution to help with the expense of the following: Art and Craft materials for the children, photocopying and printing, Aladdin message a parent system, Accelerated Reader Licences, Digital School book licences and Literacy Lift Off programme.

I also realise that back to school payments can be difficult for some families, in this case please contact me and I will give financial help in the strictest confidence. Also please note you can spread out the payments on the Aladdin epayments system.

Morning Drop Off and Evening Collection Arrangements:

- 1. **Parking**: Due to our narrow road and limited parking we need to take precautions. Please at all times leave the area directly in front of Toonagh Hall free of parked cars. This is needed as a turning point for cars and our school buses. Please do not park/drop off in the yellow box directly in front of the school gates, this space is needed for our school buses and deliveries.
 - To minimise congestion, we ask that parents would have cars turned in the direction of travel each day to help with flow of traffic. We request that you do not turn your car in any of our neighbours' driveways.
- 2. **Morning Drop Off**: The school doors will be open from 9.05 each morning, strictly no children on the school grounds before the doors open as we there will be no supervision. The doors will be opened at approx. 9.05am and supervision will start at this time.
- 3. **Evening Collection**: Only children going on the school buses will enter or exit the school through the main school gate, it is not safe for children to walk out this gate onto the road. All other entry or exit from the school should be via the pedestrian gate.
 - If any children wish to leave the school via the back gate and steps near the Basketball Court or the main gate, <u>parents/adults must collect them from here and be visible</u> as we will not allow any child leave through these gates unsupervised due to cars turning here and walking directly onto the road. The safest exit point for children is our pedestrian gate.

Thanks for your cooperation and the continued safety of all our children is of utmost importance.

Communicating with the school:

Please note our secretary Noelette works on <u>Mondays</u>, <u>Wednesdays</u> and <u>Fridays</u> and you can contact the school on these days by phone. Outside of these days we try to check the school voicemail, at the end of the school day. Outside of these days and times the phone will rarely be answered as all staff are in class. If any parent wishes to meet their child's teacher, please arrange a prior appointment. Please contact the school if you have changed your mobile number or email address and if you are not receiving texts/emails.

COVID-19 Toonagh NS Response Plan:

The latest guidelines issued to schools at the end of August state:

- Stay at home if you are unwell. The best way to keep all viruses out of school is to stay at home if you are
 unwell and until your symptoms have substantially resolved for 48 hours.
- Maintain a good standard of hand hygiene
- Adhere to good respiratory etiquette
- Ensure good ventilation arrangements
- Continue to maintain good levels of cleaning

Absences:

As a parent, you must let the school know if your child is absent and the reason why. It is school policy that reasons must be given in writing to the class teacher. Please supply the class teacher with a written note or email explaining the reason for absence for the school's records.

The school must notify TUSLA – Child and Family Agency when a child is absent for 20 days or more or where the absences gives rise to concern.

Healthy Lunches:

Our school continues to promote healthy eating with a Healthy Lunch Policy in the school. Sweets, chocolate bars, crisps and fizzy drinks are not permitted. One small treat is permitted on Friday which can be eaten at big lunch. We look forward to embracing a healthy school. Many thanks for your continued co-operation.

Label belongings:

Please ensure that all your child's belongings are clearly labelled; Jumpers, Tracksuits, Coats etc as they can get mixed up at times.

Half Day Closure for Staff Planning and Training:

The school will close on **Wednesday October 5**th @12.30 pm for a half day for a Staff meeting to facilitate staff planning. Buses will operate as normal at this time.

Junior Infant Parent Information Session:

The new Junior Infants have settled very well into school. An information session for the Junior Infant parents will be held on Friday 14th of October @ 2.15 pm in the Junior Infant Classroom.

Teacher Courses:

Under rule 58 of the Rules for Primary Schools, teachers are entitled to 3 Extra Personal Vacation (EPV) days on foot of taking part in approved summer courses. Over the summer, many of the teachers in the school have taken the time to complete these invaluable courses in a variety of valuable areas. The Department of Education will not cover the cost of a substitute for one of the

three days per teacher. The Board of Management will cover the cost of a substitute for one of the three days per teacher and class will need to be split up into other classrooms for the other teacher course day absences.

Thanks to Ruan GAA Club for funding this excellent Physical Education initiative for the girls and boys.
- Cross Country: The Cross Country Running Competition for children in 2nd 6th Class will take place in Lees Road on Thursday September 29th starting at 10.30am. All children in these classes are encouraged to take part if possible. An epayment request for the entry fee (€3) and bus fee (€5) will issue soon.
