There are a number of items I would like to bring to your attention in this May Newsletter.

School Calendar 2025/26

Please see our school calendar for 2025/26 attached to this newsletter. School will reopen on Wednesday August 27th after the summer holidays.

Free School Book Scheme school year 2025/26

All school books and copybooks your child needs, will be provided free of charge for every pupil when they return to School on August 27th. We are currently organising our book lists. There is a lot of work involved in this and we will have a further update in our June newsletter.

Hot School Meals Scheme

Toonagh NS has been approved to start this scheme when we return to school in August. The Board of Management are currently undergoing a tendering process with potential school meal providers at present. Once a school meal provider has been selected and approved by our Board of Management, details of how the school meals programme will operate will be communicated. A detailed update will be included in the coming weeks.

Standardised Testing

Standardised Testing is taking place over the coming weeks in English and Maths. Your child's results in these tests will be communicated through end of year report cards which will be posted to you.

Standardised tests are only one method used by the Department of Education and teachers to assess your child. The class teacher uses a broad range of assessment tools to evaluate learning and celebrate the achievements of your children. When evaluating and monitoring progress and attainment we do not focus solely on a test score.

Summer Uniform

Summer Uniform: Children can wear <u>plain navy shorts/or Clare coloured shorts</u> with their uniform and hopefully the nice weather continues. During the hot weather please apply sunscreen before the children come to school. They may also bring their own sunscreen to school and are encouraged to bring a sun hat and have their own water.

Also the Board of Management will have a standard Toonagh NS school shorts in place soon and you will be able to order this for your child before we return to school in August. There will be more details about this in the coming weeks.


