I would like to bring the following to your attention in this October newsletter.

School Open Night and Showcase Event:

At this information night parents can tour the facilities, find out about the school and see what Toonagh NS can offer their child. We are also inviting **prospective new parents** to come and visit our school. Refreshments will be served. We look forward to seeing you tomorrow night.

Junior Infant Parent Information Session:

An information meeting for the Junior Infant parents takes place tomorrow **Tuesday 21**st **of October starting at 7pm** in the Junior Infant Classroom. Refreshments will be served. After this meeting parents can attend our open evening in the GP hall.

Parent Teacher Meetings:

School Planning and School Self Evaluation (SSE):

School Self Evaluation is where we have to review one specific area of our teaching and learning in Toonagh NS. For the 2025-26 school year we are focussing on the pupils' English Comprehension Strategies. This focus follows on from a recommendation we received in our Curriculum Evaluation in English carried out by an inspector from the Department of Education earlier this year. At our recent half in half out staff meeting the teachers discussed and planned further strategies to develop this important area of the English Curriculum.

School Closure Dates for Training:

The Department of Education have informed us that the school will be closed to facilitate Teacher and Staff Training in Clare Education Centre on the following 3 days this school year, one each term:

Child Safeguarding:

In order to comply with the Child Protection Procedures for Primary Schools, the Board of Management recently carried out the annual review of our Child Safeguarding Statement and Risk Assessment. Jolly Phonics Spellings Programme:

For spelling practice we are using the Jolly Phonics Word lists throughout the school. Please ensure that your child practises their prescribed spellings each night.
