There are a number of items I would like to bring to your attention in this April Newsletter.

#### School Calendar 2024/25

#### Free School Book Scheme school year 2024/25

All school books and copybooks your child needs, will be provided free of charge for every pupil when they return to School on August 28<sup>th</sup>. We are currently organising our book lists. There is a lot of work involved in this and we will have a further update in our June newsletter.

#### **Standardised Testing**

Standardised Testing is taking place this week in English and next week in Maths. Your child's results in these tests will be communicated through end of year report cards which will be posted to you.

Standardised tests are only one method used by the Department of Education and teachers to assess your child. The class teacher uses a broad range of assessment tools to evaluate learning and celebrate the achievements of your children. When evaluating and monitoring progress and attainment we do not focus solely on a test score.
