School Inspection on the teaching of English

An inspector from the Department of Education recently inspected Reading, Writing and Oral Language in all classes from Infants to 6th Class over a two-day period. The quality of teaching was rated very good and well done to all the teachers. The Inspector complimented the standard of Reading in all classes from Infants to 6th. The use of levelled readers (PM levelled Readers) in all classes means that the children are reading at their correct Instructional Level and they are making great progress at their reading. The Inspector highly commended the reading interventions we have in place in all classes from Infants to 6th, these are station teaching of Reading in infants, Literacy Lift Off, Guided Reading, and Accelerated Reader and he commented very positively on the excellent culture of reading in our school.
