School Calendar 2023/24

Free School Book Scheme school year 2023/24

We are currently organising our book lists and trying to plan for the roll out of this scheme. There is a lot of work involved in this and we will have more details for you in early June.

Uniform and Tracksuit this term

This term the tracksuit days are Tuesday and Friday. The school uniform is worn the other 3 days. <u>Summer Uniform</u>: Children can wear plain navy shorts with their uniform if they wish to and hopefully we get some nice weather.

School Attendance this term

A reminder that schools are obligated & required to notify Tusla if any pupil misses over 20 days during the year, regardless of the reason(s). Therefore, it is important that the reasons for absences are accurately recorded daily on our school Rolla should the absences ever be followed up on. We thank you for providing this information via a note or via email to the class teacher. The daily attendance rate in our school continues to be very high at 94% (this time last year the attendance rate was 90%). Naturally, some pupils will have a higher absence rate if they suffer an illness during the course of the year.

Accelerated Reader, Literacy Lift Off and reading at home

Pupils in 2nd to 6th class have been taking part in the motivational reading programme Accelerated Reader (AR) this year. So far this year the children in Toonagh have read an amazing **32 million** words and **2015 books** which is fantastic reading. Please continue to encourage your children to keep up their independent reading for the rest of the school term.

1st and 2nd Class are taking part in Literacy Lift Off this term. This is an intensive language programme aimed at boosting reading fluency, comprehension, writing and phonics skills with staff members working together in stations in the classroom. This excellent levelled reading programme is coordinated by Ms. Griffin and Ms. Garrahy.

Juniors and Senior Infants have Graders Readers to read at home each night.

Please encourage your pupil to read their levelled/graded reader each night and it will help them greatly to progress with their reading.

Teacher Training on the New Curriculum

We closed on May 2nd for training on the New Curriculum which is currently being rolled out to schools. Specific focus at the moment is on the New Language Curriculum and next year a new Maths Curriculum will be introduced. There will be more training required next year and we await an update on how this will be organised.

Also at our recent training day we updated our Curriculum Policies on Music and Drama. We updated our Homework Policy and School Self Evaluation on Wellbeing. We are looking at updating the subject area of Social, Personal and Health Education (SPHE) this term.

Holy Communion

They have been practising very well for their Holy Communion and thanks very much to Ms. Garrahy for all the work she has put in to preparing the children.
